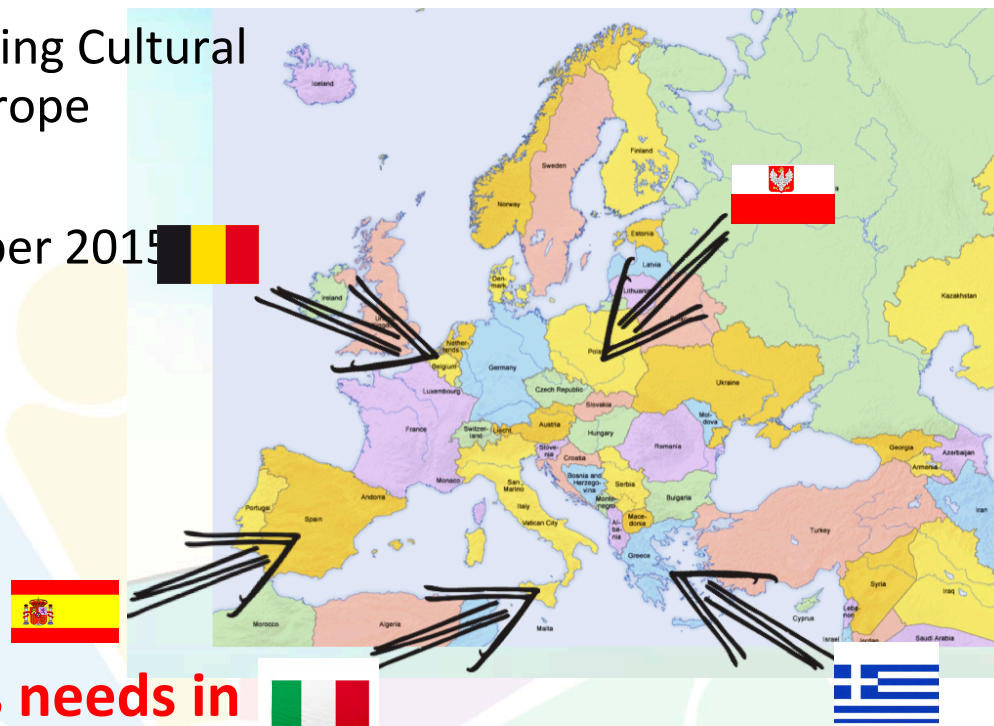

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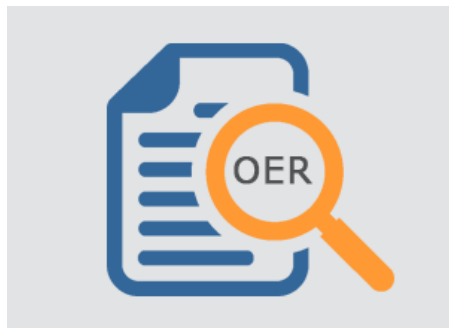
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WHY OER IN EDUCATION?

UNESCO OER Declaration 2012

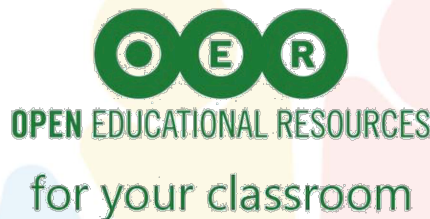
Open educational resources (OER) are any type of educational materials in the public domain, or released with an open license, that allows users to legally and freely use, copy, adapt, and re-share.



WHY OER IN EDUCATION?

Opening Up Education Communication (2013)

A mode of realising education, often enabled by digital technologies, aiming to widen access and participation and making learning accessible and customisable for all. It offers multiple ways of teaching and learning, building and sharing knowledge



The main objective of the OER is to organize the existing education resources in order to facilitate the research and their use even in different contexts allowing free access through the network, sharing activities and cooperation

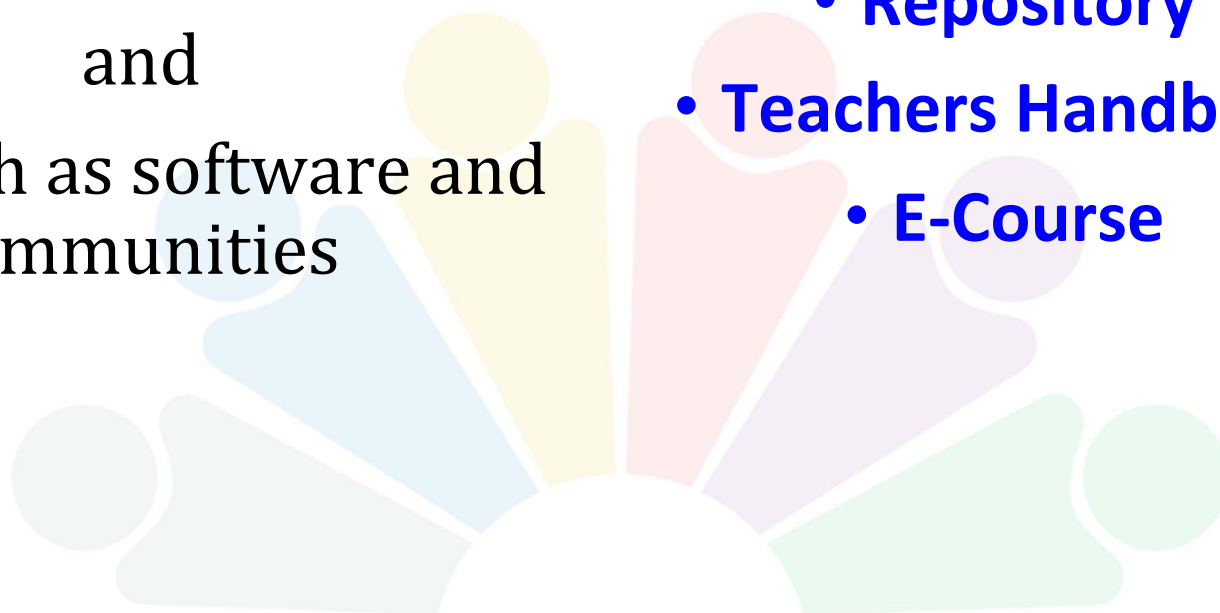

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WHAT'S IN THE MCS REPOSITORY?

- **Online database for teachers** containing **different materials** to be used with students with multicultural background;
- Teachers will be able to **integrate MCS OER** in daily activity in class using the repository contents or “**getting inspiration**” from them



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WHAT'S IN THE MCS REPOSITORY?

Repository can be used in a **creative way**:

Stimulating teachers (providing examples of traditional works, games, songs etc.)

Inspiring Teachers & students in elaborating new collaborative projects/initiatives



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WHAT KIND OF MATERIALS?

- Materials dealing with cultural background of the students: ***becoming aware of cultural patterns***
- Materials that take into account awareness of the emotional and psychological distress of immigrant children in the process of integration into new environment.
- Materials that empower **immigrant children to become active participants** in their school and local environment.
- Materials making Students aware of EU values such as solidarity, value of diversity etc.

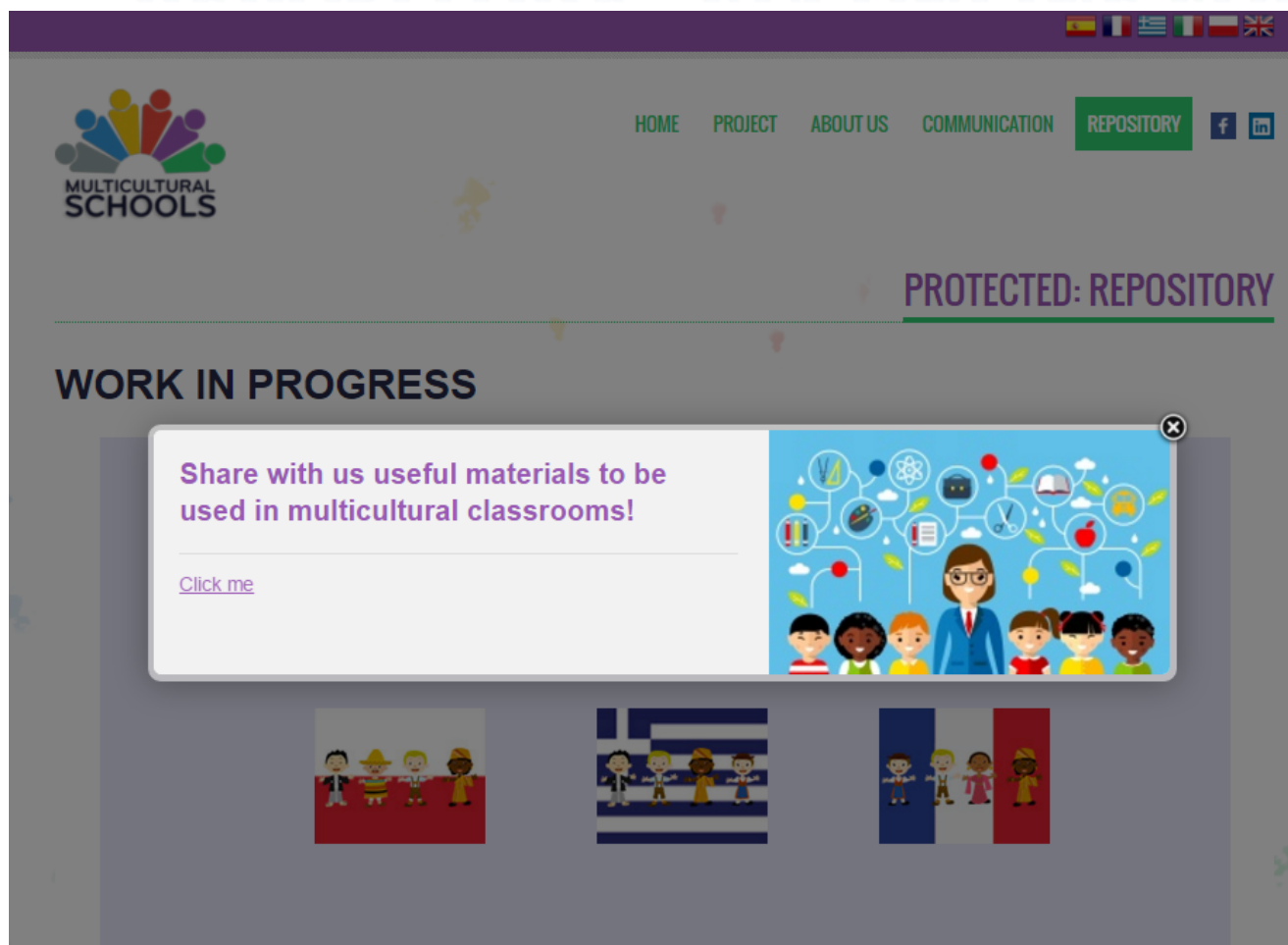

MCS TEACHERS NEEDS ANALYSIS (QUAL-QUAN)

• What the Teachers need?

- Supports, best practices and training, but...
- The most practical possible, but...
- Not strictly ready-to-use and not too general
- Teaching and learning materials focused on special learning needs of children with immigrant background;
- Collaboration with experienced teachers or other expertise

• What the Teachers do not need?

- More theoretical knowledge
